NO LIMITS OPEN
ROSEBUD SILHOUETTE AND BENCHREST RANGE
August 27, 2023

Read the description closely! There are changes from last year, and changes are highlighted in **blue**.

The group shoot at 300 yards has been eliminated. There is now a timed gong event on the Silhouette range as the second event.

NO LIMITS

- NO LIMITS on combined gun/scope/bipod weight (you read that correct!!!)
- NO LIMITS on front and rear support
- NO LIMITS on scopes
- NO LIMITS on muzzle brakes
- NO LIMITS on cartridges (except 50 BMG or variants)
- NO LIMITS on firearm configuration

- Competitor Check In and Bench Draw

- Safety Meeting
- Course of Fire Review

SCORE/BULLSEYE EVENT 300 YARDS – 9:00 AM

- 11 point target scoring (X=11)
- **200** yard NBRSA/IBS score target at **300** yards
- 3 targets (5 bulls each)
- NO LIMITS on wind flags
- NO LIMITS on sighters
- 7 min relay
- Any man sight in target provided
- Scoring – 3 target cumulative points
- Tiebreaker (Creedmoor/first miss)

MULTIPLE YARDAGE TIMED GONG EVENT – 11:00 AM

- Timed event
- Ranking/Scoring is time to complete all 6 hits
 - 2 hits at 385m ≈ **421 yds**
 - 2 hits at 300m ≈ **328 yds**
 - 2 hits at 200m ≈ **219 yds**
- Gong size approximately 2 MOA
- DESCENDING Distance for gong engagement
 - Shooter must complete BOTH hits at a yardage to progress to closer yardage
- Shooter may elect concrete bench or prone position
- Unlimited shots
- 2 active benches
- Competitor wind flags permitted, and a short time period will be provided for flag setting
- Time cap 7 mins

30 Minute Lunch Break Depending on Timing

GONG EVENT 500 METER – 1:30 PM

- All shots are for record (no practice or sighters on SUNDAY)
- Gongs are shooter's choice
- Concrete bench or prone position
- NO LIMITS on front and rear supports
- 4 active benches (2W/2E)
- 14 shots total
 - Relay 1, 7 shot relay – 7 min max (clear bench after 7th shot)
 - Break and switch benches (W↔E)
 - Relay 2, 7 shot relay – 7 min max (clear bench after 7th shot)
- Scoring
 - 16" diameter gong (1pt)
 - 8" diameter gong (5 pts)
 - 4" diameter gong (15 pts)
 - 2" gong (50 pts)
 - Max score 700
- Judge/scorekeeper will only declare "hit" or "miss"
- Shoot off to break ties
- Some pre-positioned, range provided wind flags
- NO LIMITS on competitor provided flags (time will be allowed for flag placement)

King of the Hill Grand Prizes

- 1st through 5th place cash prizes and plaques
- Ranking - Based on combined event placings

Score/Group/Gong Events

- 1st through 3rd place medals on each event

Prize Table Draw

- Competitor prize draw
- Must be in attendance to receive

Individual Registration

- Limited to **34** competitors
- **\$130** per competitor
- **Registration deadline to receive KOTH 2023 branded merchandise is July 15, 2023. Registration fee after July 15, 2023 will remain \$130.**
- Registration fees are payable in advance
- No Refunds after July 31, 2023

Other Considerations

King of the Hill is focused on individual skills, therefore;

- Same rifle in all events (in case of rifle change due to failure or malfunction, rifle change will be approved by Match Director only)
- No electronic communication with competitor
- No talking on the line
- Clear line as quickly as possible
- Windmeters are permitted
- Chronographs are permitted (but not in front of firing line)
- Any gun is legal, except:
 - 50 BMG or variants
 - Rail/return to battery rifles
 - Prohibited class firearms
- No spotters, no coaching under any circumstances
- Competitors looking behind the line during a match will be grounds for a disqualification
- Any protest will be handled by Referee Committee, and the decision is final

Other Information

- Competitors do not need to be a member of Rosebud Range or APRA
- Scoring rounds required – 35 (sighters and misses not included)
- All efforts will be made to group muzzle brake competitors together
- Range will be open SATURDAY August 26th, 2023 to competitors 9AM – 4PM for practice and 500m range sight in (non-members contact Wally Pollock at the email below to make arrangements for practice day)
